take I-24 East to exit 97 turning right to go to Wartrace onto TN 64. Follow to Wartrace (about 10 miles) and turn left onto TN 269. Turn left and go over the railroad tracks.. bear to left and then take the first right into the community of houses there .. the Normandy Presbyterian Church is one block from the storefront row.
